REPORT FROM THE FINANCE COMMISSION – MAY 2019

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

It is with gratitude that we can report on the following financial position:

Total: March 2018 – February 2019

(Figures that follow are in R '000 (hundreds of thousands))

Expense	R 2,119	926	3,045	3,054	924
Nett	R 269	-310	- 41,000	- 270,000	-442

Income for the year is above the budget due to an increase in members' contributions and additional international donations which were not budgeted for.

Expenses were kept to a minimum and we have been able to stay within the allocated budget.

The church ends the year with a deficit of R 41,000, compared to a budgeted deficit of R 270,000.

RCSS managed to limit its deficit R 310,000 compared to the budgeted deficit of R 442,000.
